

This CD-ROM is produced out of the Tyndall-AIACC scenario training workshop, 15~26 April 2002, hosted by the Tyndall Centre for Climate Change Research, School of Environmental Sciences, University of East Anglia, Norwich, UK.

What is in this CD-ROM?

Three types of materials are included in this CD:

- (1) Presentations given at the workshop by invited speakers as well as AIACC research teams. They are located at the PRESENTATIONS sub-directory;
- (2) Additional materials supplied by invited speakers and from other public sources. These include IPCC TAR chapters related to climate and non-climate scenarios and I, V&A assessments; various software manuals; UKCIP02 climate scenarios briefing report; articles on climate change vulnerability, coping capacity and adaptation supplied by Drs Neil Adger and Nick Brooks, and a few Powerpoint files on extreme weather events provided by Dr Jose Marengo. They are located at the APPENDICES sub-directory;
- (3) Workshop outline, a detailed Workshop programme, and a list of participants (including AIACC study partners and resource persons). They are located at the MISC sub-directory.

How to use this CD-ROM?

There are two ways to explore the materials in this CD:

- (1) Navigate with the index files
There are three DOC files in the main directory, each corresponding to a material type described above (e.g. presentations.doc will take you through all the presentations organised around the 6 Workshop themes). There are links to various documents listed under each material category.
- (2) Go to each individual sub-directory
You could also go to each individual sub-directory and get the exact document of your interest. The naming convention of the documents should be self-explaining.
